- Principal Update / 校长更新 / Noticias de la directora / Cập nhật từ hiệu trưởng
 - Per Principal Bowman-White, work planned on Maple's main building over the summer, seismic retrofitting, which is challenging but also some perks like some white boards being installed, etc.
 - The Intervention Entrance and Exit Document – introduced this working spreadsheet developed by staff; a collaborative plan that follows at risk students showing the plans, interventions, and outcomes to help students succeed.

 - Per Bill Eisele and Bao Ng - Maple Cares update –
 - Fundraiser started May 1 ends May 30 with a goal of \$10,000
 - \$5,060 already collected.
 - All proceeds for families that have been hit financially by COVID-19 virus.
 - Special event planned for end of month to promote donations: online talent show Tuesday, May 26 where short videos with parent permission will be posted to the public Maple PTSA Facebook page.
 - Per Principal Bowman-White – a consideration for the donation - 25 students still without devices for online learning, after the district's distribution of chrome books.
